Caution

TYRE SHINE is flammable. Avoid sources of ignition. Avoid skin contact and avoid inhaling vapours.

- Make sure tyres have been washed and allowed to dry.
- When dry, spray or wipe TYRE SHINE onto tyre walls with a cloth.
- Spread TYRE SHINE evenly across the surface, working it into grooves and raised lettering.
- Do not apply to the tread of the tyre as this will make it slippery.

NOTE: Do not use on motor-cycles or other two-wheeled vehicles, or any surfaces that should not become slippery. Remove any spilled product from cement or asphalt immediately and clean area with detergent.

First Aid
